WIZnet Conflict Minerals Policy

This document contains WIZnet's statement regarding the content of Conflict Minerals in our products. This statement is based upon information collected from WIZnet's supply chain, manufacturing facilities and affiliates worldwide.

WIZnet has a high level of concern regarding human tragedies occurring in the Democratic Republic of the Congo and surrounding countries. WIZnet and its manufacturing groups take corporate governance and business ethics seriously.

WIZnet is aware of Section 1502 "Conflict Minerals" of the Dodd-Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act, and committed to take all appropriate steps to avoid illegal and unethical metal sourcing coming from Conflict Region. The metals at issue are Tantalum(Ta), Tungsten(W), Cobalt(Co), Gold (AU) and Tin (Sn). WIZnet does not procure these minerals for any of our products.

WIZnet have conducted a reasonable inquiry of our suppliers. Currently, none of our suppliers have reported to us sourcing from the Conflict Region. We will be educating our suppliers about the intent behind the regulations and asking them to submit written evidence that raw materials used to produce WIZnet products, do not originate from mining or smelting operations in the Conflict Region.
